



DECIDING WHETHER TO GO TO GRADUATE SCHOOL

WHY ATTEND? A graduate degree may nurture your intellectual curiosity and spark passion for you to impact social change

- Opportunity to:
 - Immerse yourself in specific area of interest
 - Contribute to ideas and conversations that influence society
- Opportunity to participate in and share research, often with funding; examples at KU:
 - PhD student in Economics studying birth outcomes for Physicians
 - KU graduate student research highlights
 - Capitol Graduate Research Summit
 - 3-Minute Thesis Competition

DECIDING WHETHER TO GO TO GRADUATE SCHOOL

WHY ATTEND?

Should you work first or immediately enroll in graduate school?

- Career goals
 - Will you need work experience? What kind (fulltime, assistantship, internship, etc.)?
 - Do you need work experience to get the most out of your graduate program?
- Program and degree-level
 - Are you interested in a master's or doctoral degree?
 - Are you interested in research or a professional degree?

DECIDING WHETHER TO GO TO GRADUATE SCHOOL

OTHER CONSIDERATIONS

What kind of financial and time investments are involved?

- Funding and costs
 - How will you fund your program?
 - How much are you willing to invest?
- Time commitment
 - How long should you estimate it will take to complete your program?

DECIDING WHETHER TO GO TO GRADUATE SCHOOL

OTHER CONSIDERATIONS

Graduate School is Discipline Focused

- Participate in hands-on training
- Small class sizes
- Gain expert knowledge in a subject area and develop specialized skills
 - > Masters
 - Doctoral



WHAT GRADUATE SCHOOL LOOKS LIKE?

DISCIPLINE-FOCUSED

Graduate School is Student-Centered

- Original Research, Creative Work, Practice
 - Investigate original research question
 - Create original art, music, literature, etc.
 - Deepen knowledge and innovate applications of knowledge
- Supervisors, advisors, and committee
 - Professional programs may have dedicated advisors (staff and faculty)
 - Common research interests
 - One-on-one interactions—do your personal work styles mesh?
 - Research group dynamics

WHAT GRADUATE SCHOOL LOOKS LIKE?

STUDENT -CENTERED

Milestone Exams and Theses/Dissertations

- Milestone exams
 - > Qualifying exams
 - Comprehensive exams
 - Oral
 - ✤ Written
 - Final Defense
 - Public presentation, performance, installation
 - Oral exam with committee
- Written
 - Thesis vs non-thesis
 - Dissertation, capstone project, performance, or other culminating effort
 - May include original materials (e.g. maps, works of art, musical scores, etc.) in addition to data.

WHAT GRADUATE SCHOOL LOOKS LIKE?

MILESTONE EXAMS AND THESES/ DISSERTATIONS

Time Investment

Unlike undergraduate courses, research and creativity do not necessarily run on a semester time-scale, nor are there clear grades associated with progress.

- Full-time (MS ~1-2yrs; PhD ~4-5 yrs)
 - 6-9 hours of coursework per semester
 May include 20 hrs per week in Assistantship
 - > Plus time for research, writing, practicing, etc.
 - May or may not include travel
- Part-time (extended time to degree)
 - > 3-6 hours coursework per semester
 - \succ Plus time for research, etc.
 - > Often while working full-time job.
- Work-life balance is key to success!






